**Prof. Hiroshi Miyasaka**

(Osaka Univ., Japan)

○ Biography

Hiroshi Miyasaka is a professor in Graduate School of Engineering Science of Osaka University. He received PhD in 1985 from Osaka University under the supervision of Prof. Noboru Mataga. After that, he worked as a Research Associate in the laboratory of Prof. Mataga. In 1991, he was appointed as an associate professor of Kyoto Institute of Technology and a full professor of Osaka University in 2003. His research interest has been focused on the dynamics and mechanism of photochemical reactions and the exploration of new photo-responses in condensed phase by means of multiple-photon excitation. He received Morino Science Award from the Morino Foundation for Molecular Science in 1998, Japanese Photochemistry Association Award in 2002 and APA Masuhara Lectureship Award in 2018. He is a Foreign Fellow of National Academy of Sciences, India, since 2017.
